Students in Pakistan receive results from Cambridge June 2026 exam series

In Pakistan over 100,000 students from over 850 schools sat for June 2026 exam series for Cambridge International AS & A Level and Cambridge O Level and IGCSE this year. The most popular subjects in Pakistan being Physics, Mathematics, Business, Chemistry and Computer Science.
